101 Intermediate Knitting (8 hrs) Cost \$70.00

Prerequisite: Beginning Knitting Class or teacher permission

Materials: One skein worsted weight yarn, one set US size 8 or 9 needle.

Go beyond the basics of beginning knitting and learn techniques you will be able to use to take on more challenging projects. Learn how to read patterns and yarn labels, increases and decreases, how to knit cables, how to work with circular needles and double pointed needles, how to correct mistakes, how to join seams and grafting. Students will knit various small projects throughout the class such as a cell phone case, teddy bear sweater, dishcloths and mittens.

Materials: Sock Weight Yarn that produces a “fair isle” pattern. Approximately 600 yards of self- patterning sock yarn and 200 yards of plain color to match. US size 2 or 3 needles, blunt needle, stitch holders and markers. Pattern for purchase at store.

This cute sweater for newborn to 6 months is fun to knit and all your friends will be impressed with all your color change work! Just don't tell them that the yarn does all the work for you!

In this class you will make a small project to learn the intarsia technique. Intarsia is knitting a picture or motif into your pattern generally using another color of yarn. You will learn how to change colors so you will not have holes in your work.

110 Beginning Fair Isle (4 hr) \$40.00

Prerequisite: Intermediate Knitting

Materials: DK or Worsted weight yarns, needles to achieve gauge, pattern of your choice..

Fair Isle knitting is creating a pattern using two different colors of yarn in each row of knitting. This class will teach you how to knit holding one color in each hand and how to strand the yarn across the back of your work to create a clean finish. Use pattern and yarn of your choice – preferably something that can be knit in the round – such as mittens. Mary will teach you how to do the same techniques knitting flat.

Confused by the whole heel flap, turn and gusset part of knitting socks? Learn to knit socks from the toe up on double pointed needles using a provisional cast on toe and short row heel and avoid the whole gusset issue!

Try this great method of knitting two socks at the same time using one long circular needle! You will learn to cast on, work through the heel and finish up your pair of socks!

Material: Yarn to be chosen at first class.

This very simple t-shirt pattern can be knit with either DK or Worsted Weight Yarn. Changes in stitches create a lovely pattern. Simple knit in sleeves so no sewing in sleeves!

117 Entrelac Scarf (2hr) Cost \$40.00

Prerequisite: Intermediate or Advanced Beginner

Material: 2 Skeins (400-500 yds worsted weight yarn. US size 8-10, 24" circular needles, tapestry needle and Size J Crochet Hook for applying fringe, stitch markers, and row counter.

Entrelac is a technique of knitting triangles and squares continuously without seaming later. Different colored yarn or variegated yarns are stunning in this geometric form of knitting. Join Billy as he teaches you how to knit a beautiful scarf using this fun technique.

CLASS POLICIES

Students will receive a 15% discount on Yarn Purchases Only from the time the class is paid in full until the day of the last class. This applies to full priced yarn only. It is the student's responsibility to inform the cashier BEFORE she rings up your purchase that you are in a class and should receive the discount. Classes must be 50% paid at the time of registration in order to hold your spot.

Upon signing up for the class, any changes in attendance must be made three days prior to the start of the class. If you need to cancel a class, we will issue you a store credit for the amount or transfer you to the next available spot in a future class. Cancellations made with fewer than 7 days notice result in a forfeiture of registration fee.

If you must miss a session of a class, please call in advance to let us know. You may be able to take that session the next time the class is offered but only if space is available. You can also schedule a private lesson at a cost of \$25.00 per hour with the instructor.

Classes have minimum enrollments; if these are not met, we reserve the right to cancel classes with 24 hours notice. Refunds for classes we cancel will be given in the method paid.
